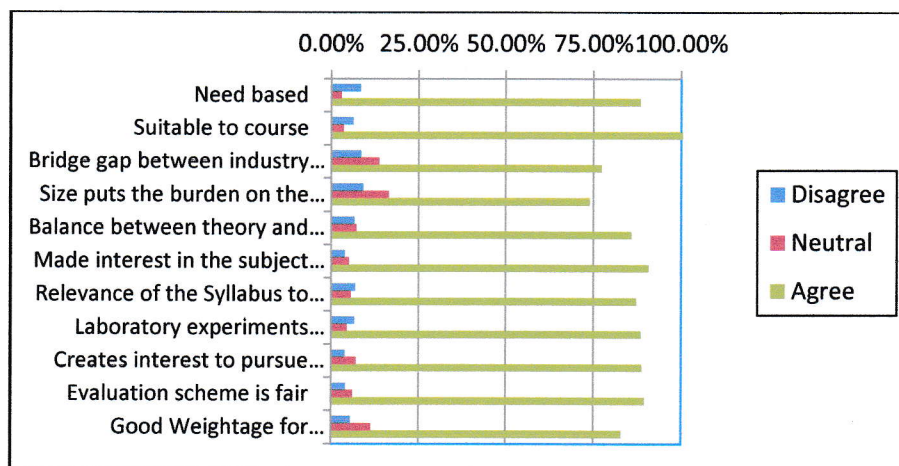
1. Feedback on the Curriculum

- 6.44 % students disagree with the syllabus content.

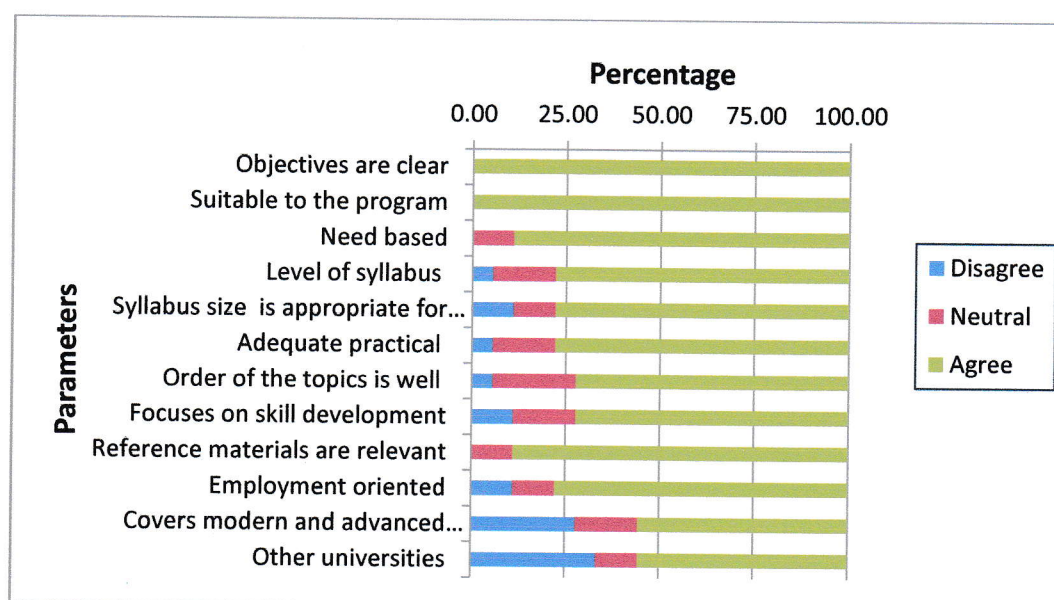

- Project for final year and some important topics should be included in the syllabus.

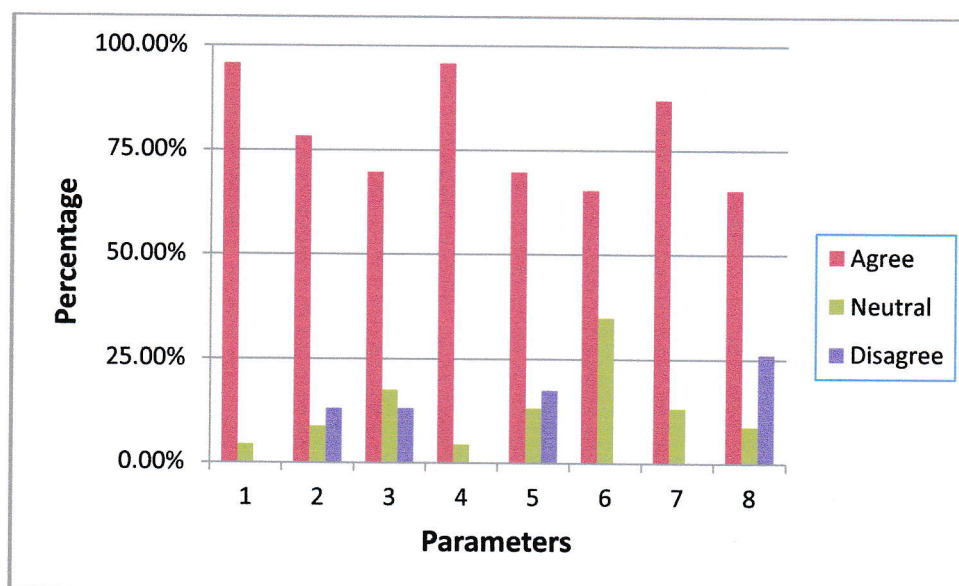
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C) Feedback of Alumni on Curriculum

- 95.65% of the students agreed that the curriculum of the programme was well structured.

- 65.22% students agreed that the curriculum focused on employability, while 8.70% students were neutral and 26.09% students disagreed.

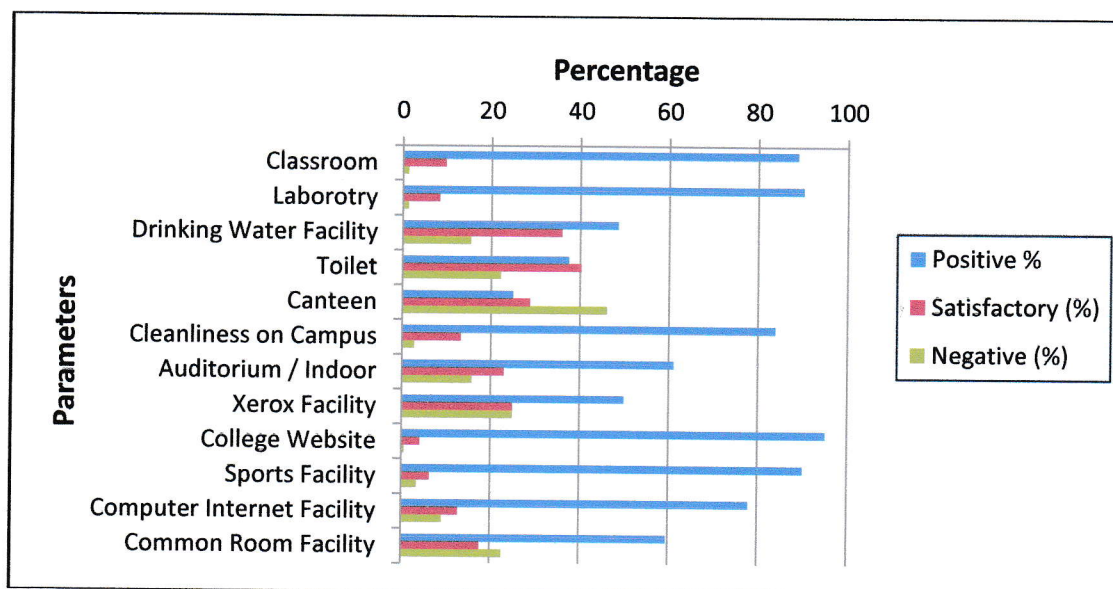

- Improve the Xerox facility and also need to canteen services.

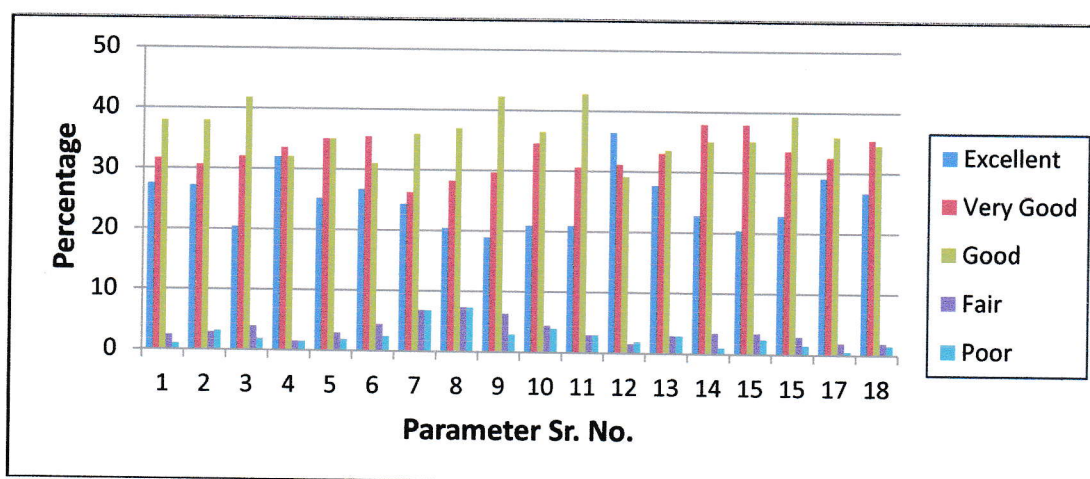

- 02.63% students have given negative remarks on the Library.

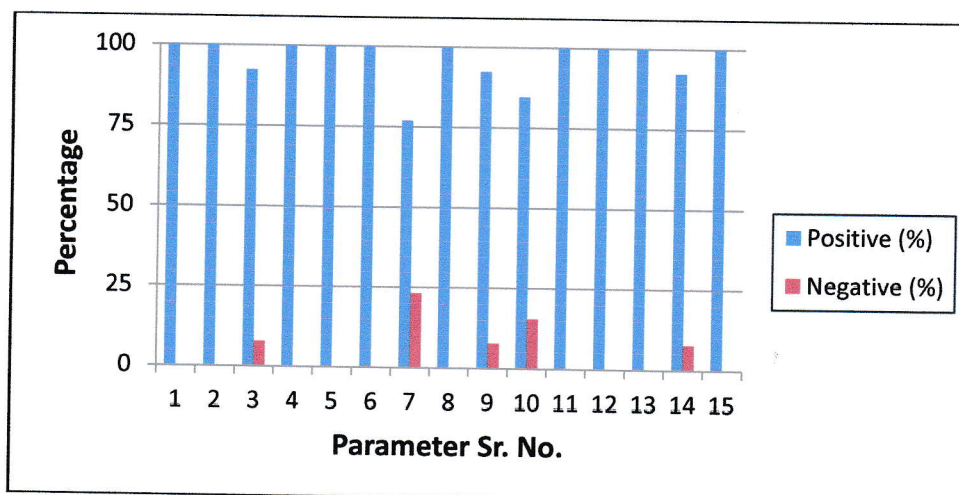

- One of the teachers suggested the need for collaborative work among the staff.

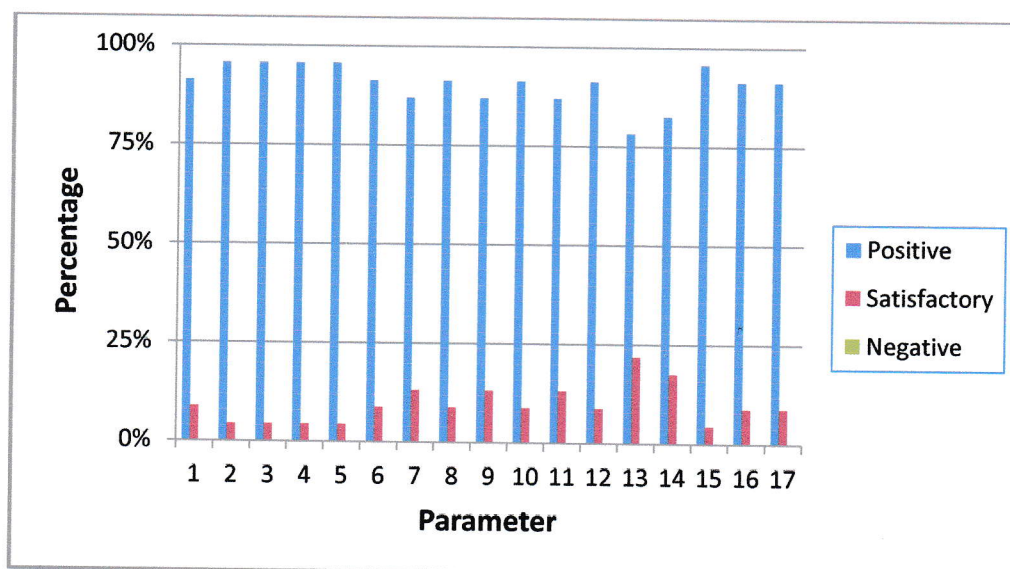

- No negative responses have been given.

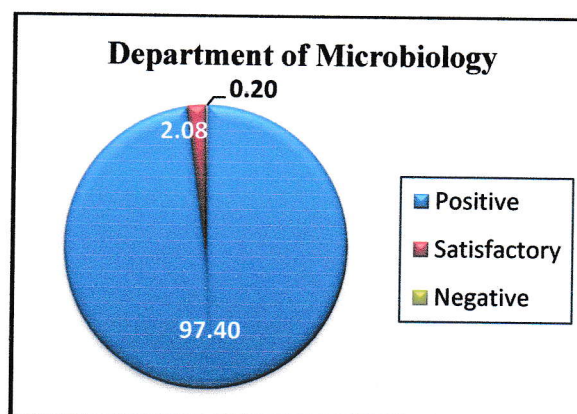
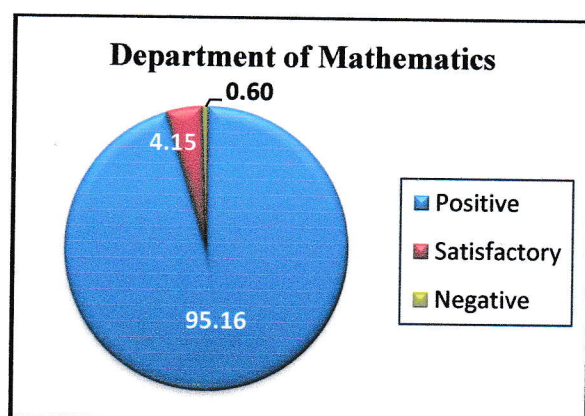
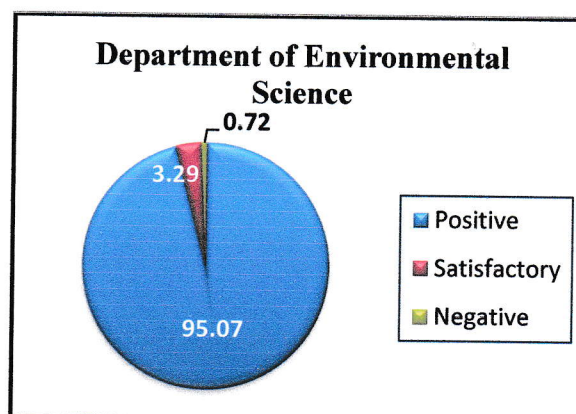
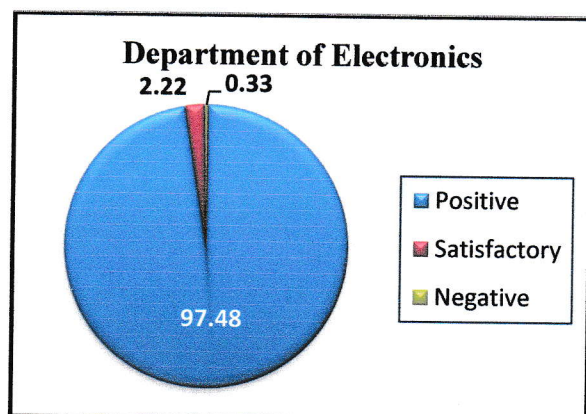
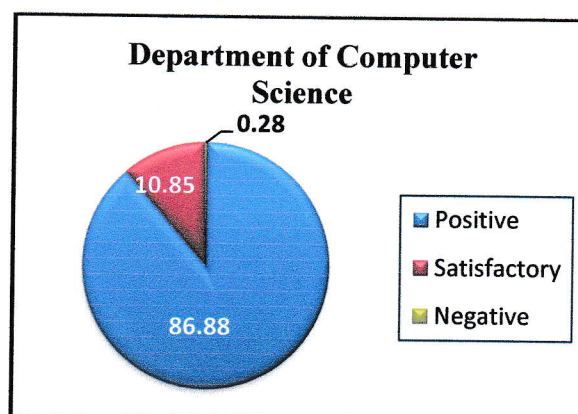
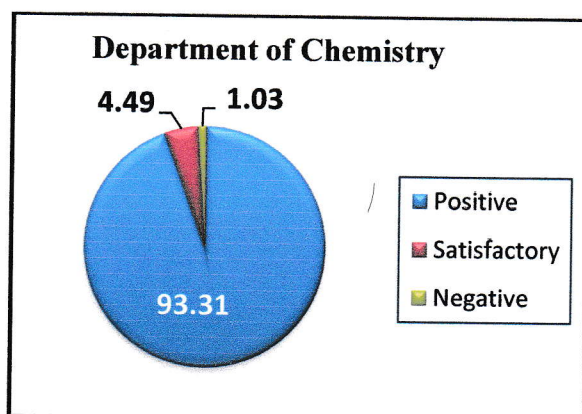
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6. Student Feedback on Teachers

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Analysis and Outcomes

An effort was made to access the student feedback on teachers. As many as 21 questions were asked to the student on the various aspects like teacher's regularity, class preparation, guidance and mentoring, etc. These feedbacks were collected and analyzed at department level. The head of the department collected feedback from all the classes for the respective teachers. An analysis report of this was prepared and then submitted to the IQAC. IQAC took necessary action as per the analysis. A sum of 2207 responses was received from the students and same is discussed below.

- 94.22% students have given positive feedback to all teachers. Individuals with slightly less positive responses were suggested for improvement.
- 04.51% students are satisfied with the Faculty at college. HoDs are being advised to monitor the teaching-learning process for further improvement.
- The feedback of the students about teachers leads us to the conclusion that they are very much happy with the teachers and their way of teaching and the way they complete their syllabus and encourage the students for other activities.

Action Taken Report

1. Many of our teachers are now using ICT for teaching learning purposes to create smart learning environment.
2. Slow learners and advanced learners are given more attention according to their needs.
3. Skill-oriented courses have been introduced to bridge the knowledge gap and to make students more skilled.
4. Placement and guidance cell have been strengthened.
5. Teachers are asked to undertake more experiential teaching learning process. Teachers are also using PowerPoint presentations for enhancing teaching learning experience.
6. Various add-on, value added courses which are helpful for the beneficial of students are introduced.


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
