PUBLIC NOTICE

CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS

It is brought to the notice of the Institutions, students and other various stakeholders that ragging is a criminal offence and UGC has framed regulations, on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational institution, in order to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging. The regulations have been notified vide No. F. 1-16/2009 (CPP-II) dated 21.10.2009 and are available on UGC website www.ugc.ac.in.

The above mentioned regulations are mandatory and shall apply to all Universities established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State/Union Territory Act and all Institutions recognized by or affiliated to such

Universities and all Institutions deemed to be Universities under Section (3) of the UGC Act, 1956 with effect from 4th July, 2009 i.e. the date of its Publication in the official Gazette. All institutions are required to take necessary steps for its implementation in toto including the monitoring mechanism as per provisions provided in the above regulation and ensure its strict compliance. The following preventive measures for

Anti-Ragging should also be strictly followed:-

- 1) The Institutions may erect suitable hoardings/bill boards/banners in prominent places within the campus to exhort the students to prevent or not to indulge in ragging and also indicating therein the names of the officials and their telephone numbers to be contacted in case of ragging.
- 2) All Educational Institutions should form an Anti-Ragging-Committee and squads and dedicated cadre of wardens and professional counselors to ensure that the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India and Justice Raghavan Committee recommendations are followed without exception.
- 3) An affidavit must be obtained from every Student, Parent/Guardian separately as per clause (m & n) of Regulation 6.2.
- 4) The Institution may also undertake other forms of campaign as it may consider appropriate for prevention of ragging.
- 5) UGC has uploaded a film on anti-ragging on its website. All universities and colleges are requested to download the same and give wide publicity amongst the students, before the start of the academic session. Besides, this may be constantly monitored during the entire period of the academic session.

Any violation of UGC regulations as cited above or if any Institution fails to take adequate steps to prevent ragging or act in accordance with these regulations or fails to punish perpetrators of incidents of ragging suitably, UGC shall call for punitive action against erring institutions.

Cigarettes and Tobacco products Selling is strictly prohibited in the area within a radius of 100 (one hundred) yards of this Educational Institution. Offenders are liable to face action.

The action will be taken on the points mentioned in the UGC Circular No. No. F. 1-9/2006 (CPP-II) October, 2006 and UGC letter No D. O. No. 1-9/2006(CPP-II)/ March.2013 dated 03 April 2013.

CIRCULAR

“The Cigarettes and other Tobacco Products (Prohibition of Advertisement and regulation of Trade and Commerce, Production, Supply and Distribution) Act, 2003” which came into effect from 1st May, 2004. contains certain provisions pertaining to educational institutions. In order to ensure effective implementation of these provisions of the Act, the Universities are requested to take necessary action on the following points:-

- 1 The 'Boards' as prescribed under the rules are to be displayed outside the premises of the University and its affiliated colleges, prominently stating that sale of cigarettes and tobacco products in an area with in a radius of 100 (one hundred) yards of the University is strictly prohibited and that such sale is an offence punishable with the fine which may extend to two hundred rupees;
- 2 Action has to be taken to sensitize the teaching and non-teaching staff of the University and its affiliated colleges on the issue so that the system is in place immediately.
- 3 The names of the persons authorized to ensure the implementation of this system may be duly notified
- 4 The shops, if any, selling cigarettes and other tobacco products around the University, are to be got removed immediately.

The copy of the Act and related O. Ms/Circulars have already been sent to the Education Secretary of your State/UT by the Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Education, New Delhi.

All the Universities and Deemed Universities are requested to take necessary action to ensure the implementation of the provisions of this Act

This may also be brought to the notice of the colleges affiliated to the universities.

4. Student are prohibited from forming associations/organization and from holding functions in the college without prior permission of the Principal.
5. Student are prohibited from organizing welcome and farewell and other such functions outside college premises. Violation shall attract severe disciplinary action.
6. Any change of address must be notified to the college office immediately.
7. Make full use of your time and the facilities provided by the college.
8. For details of the curriculum refer to the syllabus of University as the case may be.
9. The Student carry the responsibility of maintaining cleanliness in the campus. Dust bins have been provided at suitable places for this purpose .Anyone found throwing litter (dirt) on the college premises or spitting on the wall or causing a dirtiness will be severely penalised.
10. During working hours, use of mobile in the college campus is not allowed.
11. The Principal's decision in all matters of permission, administration, enforcement of discipline, general rules and special instructions mentioned in this prospectus shall be final and binding on all.

9. DISCIPLINE

The following rules have been framed for maintenance of discipline for the students of this college

1. National anthem sung regularly in the college.
2. Students shall have to obey all the instructions of the Principal. The Students are answerable to him for their behaviour in general, both inside and outside the college campus. The names of students found violating the rules of the college administration or behaving in an undisciplined manner will be removed from the college. It will be presumed on admission that the students concerned and their parents have read and concurred with these rules.
3. Students should behave respectfully with all staff members and politely with their fellow students. Any act of disobedience improper and discourteous exchange of words or passing of indecent remarks specially on girl student is punishable offence and will be viewed seriously.
4. Students should make careful use of college books, room, furniture, fans, laboratory equipment and the college property in general. The cost of damage done to it would be recoverable from students either individually or collectively as the case may be.
5. Only special notices shall be read out in the classroom. Students therefore, should see the notice board daily and keep themselves well informed about the various notices that may be put up there from time to time.
6. No students shall directly send any information concerning the college for publication either to the press or elsewhere without prior approval and the necessary permission of the Principal. Further without prior permission, he/she should not approach the President or the C.D.C. Member except through the college Principal. Any breach of this rule may lead to outright expulsion of the student from the college.
7. The students should not roam in corridors during working hours of free classes, instead they should utilize the library, sport and internet facilities.
8. There is strictly prohibition on smoking and chewing the substances like tobacco, gutkha, pan etc. in the college campus.
9. There is strictly prohibition on drinking and carrying alcoholic substances in the campus.

Admissions are subjected to the eligibility norms of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Amravati.

Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) :

I) For B.Sc I - (Sem. I & II)

All Students passed in HSC examination of Maharashtra State Board of Examination with relevant subjects of Science faculty OR any equivalent examination (equivalence given by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University) are eligible for B.Sc I Admission.

For Group I, i.e., Microbiology, Chemistry and Environmental Science student must have passed H. S. C. examination with Biology subject.

For Group II, i.e., Electronics, Computer Science & Mathematics student must have passed H. S. C. examination with Mathematics subject.

II) For B.Sc. II- (Sem. III & IV)

All Students of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University passed or exempted with ATKT in B.Sc I examination OR any equivalent examination are eligible for B.Sc II Admission. They have to continue the optional subjects offered in B.Sc I.

III) For B.Sc III- (Sem. V & VI)

All Students of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University passed or exempted with ATKT in B.Sc II examination are eligible for B.Sc III Admission.

Bachelor of Arts (B. A.) :

I) For B.A. I - (Sem. I & II)

All Students passed in HSC examination of Maharashtra State Board of Examination with relevant subjects of Art faculty OR any equivalent examination (equivalence given by Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University) are eligible for B.A. I Admission. (Sem. I)

II) For B.A. II- (Sem. III & IV)

All Students of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University passed or exempted with ATKT in B.A. I examination OR any equivalent examination are eligible for B.A II Admission. They have to continue the optional subjects offered in B.A. I.

III) For B.A. III- (Sem. V & VI)

All Students of Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University passed or exempted with ATKT in B.A. II examination are eligible for B.A. III Admission.

Note :- The applicant for admission, at the end of the course of study of a particular semester to an examination specified in column (1) of the table below, shall be eligible to appear at it, if,

- (i) he/she satisfied the condition in the table and the provisions thereunder.
- (ii) he/she has prosecuted a regular course of study in a college affiliated to the University.
- (iii) he/she has in the opinion of the Principal shown the satisfactory progress in his/her studies.

8.18 Uniform For the college students.

In the college premises the uniform is compulsory for the college students. There is relaxation of uniform on every Thursday. The Uniform for the students is as follows -

8.8 a Physical Efficiency Test:
